### "PLAY OF THE DAY" INSTRUCTIONS

(All events payout to 1/3 of the field)

Big Easy	Total the 9 Easiest holes (3, 5, 8, 9, 12, 13, 15, 16 and 18) and subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ handicap
Convert one Hole to Par	Choose one hole score and convert it to par. Subtract your full Handicap.
Criss Cross	Choose your best score between holes 1/10, 2/11, 3/12, 4/13, 5/14, 6/15, 7/16, 8/17 & 9/18. Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ handicap
Double your Pleasure	Select your best nine holes and double your score. Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your full handicap.
Dr. Pepper	Subtract scores for holes 10, 2 and 4. Subtract full handicap.
Even Holes	Total holes 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, and 18. Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your Handicap
Fore!!!	Total all Par 4s. Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap.
Golf is Hard	Total the 9 Hardest holes (1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14 and 17) and subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap
Hate 'em	Before you tee off, circle 2 holes to be tossed out. Total all other holes and subtract your full handicap.
Landlubber	Total all non-water holes (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 14, 15 and 17). Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap.
Middle of the Road	Total the scores for the middle nine holes (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14). Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap.
Odd Holes	Total holes: 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, and 17. Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your Handicap
Pick 3	Pick three par 3s, three par 4s, and three par 5s. Subtract you're your handicap
Putt for Dough	Total the number of putts, on the green. Players with fewest putts win.
Synchronized Swimming	Total all water holes (1, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16 and 18) and subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap.
Ts and Fs	Total all holes that begin with 'T' or 'F' (2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 12, 13, 14 and 15). Subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your Handicap.
3s & 5s	Total all par 3s and par 5s then subtract $\frac{1}{2}$ of your handicap.
Wing and a Prayer	Before you tee-off, select one hole to toss out; after you complete the round, select a second hole to toss out. Total the remaining 16 holes and subtract your full handicap.

SPECIAL EVENTS**

**CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP - NET CHAMPIONSHIP:**

This is a two-week tournament. The Club Champion is the player with the two lowest combined gross scores. Net Champion is the player with the two lowest combined net scores.

There are also flight winners.

**PARTNER BEST BALL:**

This a one-day tournament. Two members play as a team. Partners select their lowest net score for each hole, then add the scores for the game score. The teams with the lowest overall net scores win.

**STATE MEDALLION:**

This Low Gross/Low net tournament is spread over four weeks. The player with the two best gross scores and the player with the two best net scores over these weeks will represent the league at the AGA statewide tournament.

**TURKEY TROT:**

This is the annual Thanksgiving event. Players are given a "turkey" with their game score (72 + handicap). Once a player reaches their game score, they place their turkey in the ground, where the ball came to rest. The players who make it the farthest on the course are the winners.

**OPENING DAY, CHRISTMAS PARTY AND FUN DAY:**

These are "ABCD" Best Ball events. Foursomes are assigned. Players circle the two lowest net scores per hole, then add the scores for the total score. Teams with the lowest net scores are winners
